APPLICATION PROCESS:

The nominator must collect the following, and send all materials in one packet to:
NELMS, 460 Boston Street, Topsfield, MA 01983, by 4:30 p.m. on October 3, 2008.

The nominator, who must be from the same school district, must address in writing how the nominee meets the four criteria stated above, in one thousand words or less, (250 words per criteria).

The **nominator** must collect one letter of support, of not more than five hundred (500) words, from each of the following:

- An administrator from within the system
- A middle level teacher from within the system
- A student, a parent and/or community member associated with a middle level school from within the system

The nominee must write five hundred (500) words or less in the response to the question,
“How have you impacted the lives of middle school students as an administrator?”

RECOGNITION:

Those that receive an award will be recognized at the NELMS Annual Conference, receive a one-day registration to our annual conference, be given a one-year membership, and will be recognized in Mid Lines, the NELMS newspaper.
