PURPOSE – This program is intended to give public recognition to two representative 5th-8th grade students from New Hampshire who distinguished themselves in terms of outstanding Middle Level scholarship and leadership. In past years, schools throughout the state have recognized hundreds of NH students. *The selection of these students will be the responsibility of each school. (See selection criteria.)*

This typically includes qualities such as:

- Teamwork
- Positive Interactions with others
- Respect
- Dependability
- Productivity
- Service to others
- Personal Goals
- Respect for diversity

VIRTUAL AWARDS CELEBRATION – The 2 students selected and a school representative, and others, are invited to attend the statewide Virtual Scholar Leader Awards Celebration. Each student will receive a plaque with his or her name on it signifying the honor, which will be mailed to the school after the event so that schools who might like to honor their students again at their end-of-year celebration can present the plaque to the students at that time.

COST TO SCHOOLS – Schools who are a member of NHAMLE and/or NELMS will be able to register their Scholar Leaders for this virtual event for \$129.00. This price includes the two plaques and event registration for three (2 families and 1 school representative). If a school is currently not a member of NHAMLE and/or NELMS, the price will be \$209.00. This price includes the two plaques and event registration for three (2 families and 1 school representative).

SPECIAL OFFERS FOR THIS VIRTUAL EVENT – We know that this year might have been trying on your students and we understand that you might want to honor more than two students, so your school will have the opportunity to honor additional students! The price for each additional student will be \$40.00 which will include a plaque and 1 event registration for the family of the student. 2022 Selection Criteria

All decisions concerning selection have a certain subjective element. However, New Hampshire Middle Level Educators and New England League of Middle Schools urge schools to follow the recommended criteria described below. Procedures for selection used at the school must be fair, non-discriminatory, and consistently applied.

It is suggested that two students, one male and one female, from eighth grade be selected (unless your school has all female or male students). Seventh grade student recipients are appropriate if that is the highest grade in your school.

The following criteria are suggested:

- Excellent attitude towards learning
- Provides service to classmates and school
- Is a positive role model for peers
- Takes responsibility for own behavior and learning

These additional indicators may be of assistance:

- ✓ Exercises influence on peers in upholding school ideals
- ✓ Contributes ideas that improve the civic life of the school
- ✓ Shows leadership in group situations
- ✓ Shows respect for self and others
- ✓ Exemplifies positive attitudes and inspires positive behavior in others
- ✓ Demonstrates academic initiative and is willing to uphold scholarship
- ✓ Demonstrates leadership in the classroom and school activities
- ✓ Is dependable in any responsibility undertaken
- ✓ Volunteers and is gladly available and willing to sacrifice to offer assistance to others
- ✓ Accepts criticism willingly and recommendations graciously
- ✓ Exemplifies desirable qualities of character and integrity
