The nominator must collect the following and submit all materials electronically to nelms@nelms.org by **February 1**.

- A copy of the unit with student work/products samples
- One- or two-page summary of the unit explaining in 500 words or less how this unit meets the criteria using specific examples

Recognition:

Those who receive an award will be recognized at the NELMS Annual Conference and in *MidLines*, receive one(1) two-day registration to our Annual Conference, and be featured on the web site.

The recipient will also be invited to present the award to next year's award winner at the Annual Conference Welcome & Recognitions Reception.
